The Emergency Department at SFI is a valuable, life-saving resource for our 30,000 neighbors who live and work in the Interquest area and the city of Monument. In addition, the Flight for Life helicopter base enables faster transport and patient access.

St. Clare History

The 24-foot, four-ton custom statue of St. Clare greets patients, visitors, and caregivers with open arms at the front entrance on the east side of the hospital. At night, she shines as LED lights stream through the weather-proof structure from within. St. Clare’s light reminds us that God is with us, even in our darkest moments.

To commemorate St. Clare’s legacy, both in spirit and design, the Penrose–St. Francis Hospital Foundation commissioned one of the Western region’s finest sculptors, Dale Claude Lamphere, to design and build the inspiring custom sculpture.

Prior to sainthood, Clare dedicated her life to God at an early age. When she was 18, Francis of Assisi came to preach in a nearby church. Inspired by his words, Clare asked Francis to help her dedicate her life to God.

The statue embodies St. Clare’s spirit of hospitality, courage, and love. Her outstretched arms say, **“Welcome. You are loved. Healing happens here.”**

Technology Highlights

• Smart rooms

SFI delivers exceptional experiences by using advanced patient engagement solutions within a smart room environment. During their stay, patients have access to a personal tablet in their pre-assigned room that gives them control of their environment such as adjusting temperature, lights, and window shades.

They can also order food, and access entertainment, spiritual care and other support services while they receive treatment and recover from surgeries. These interactive hospital rooms, combined with our compassionate medical teams transforms patient care in northern Colorado Springs.

• Real Time Location System

SFI is implementing a Real-Time Location System (RTLS) throughout the facility to help streamline operations, promote staff safety, and enhance patient care. A single platform processes the location data to provide real-time map views and alerts, as well as robust analytics which help to identify opportunities for workflow improvement.

• SLD AirFrames on operating room ceilings

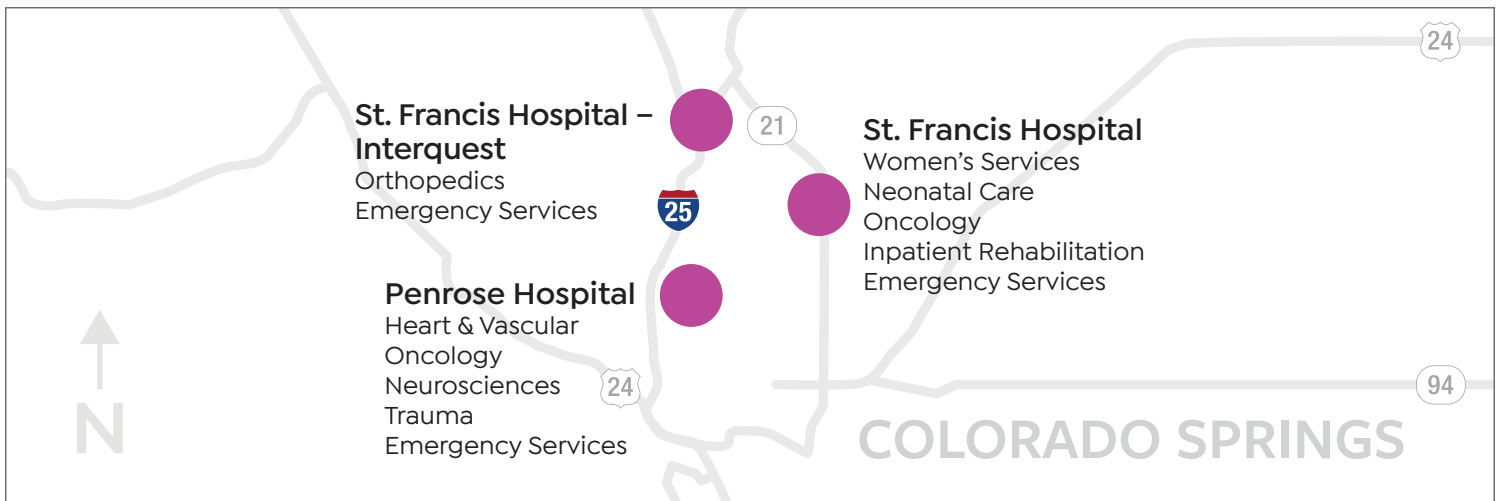
This technology uses waves of air to reduce the potential for contamination at the surgical site. The waves are harmless to patients, but detrimental to bacteria in the OR.
