St. Francis Hospital opened in August 2008. This 317 licensed bed facility is the only full-service hospital in northern Colorado Springs and features a modern Birth Center, Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric Care Unit, Emergency Department, Level III Trauma Center, Imaging Services, Surgical Services and Critical Care Unit. It is also the home base for the Flight For Life Colorado air ambulance helicopter service.



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Our non-profit, faith-based hospital is the cornerstone of health care services for the Pikes Peak region with 24-hour emergency and acute care services.

Noteworthy areas of care include:

- St. Francis Hospital's acclaimed heart program consistently achieves outcomes that exceed national benchmarks.
- St. Francis Hospital is home to the Total Joint and Spine Center, a state-of-the-art unit that caters to patients who have undergone joint or spine surgery. Our expert surgeons, fully coordinated team of clinical staff, physical therapists and nurse navigators provide a full continuum of care from diagnosis to rehabilitation.
- St. Francis Hospital specializes in maternal-child health with a state-of-the-art birthing center and Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.
- The St. Francis Cancer Center includes a full range of multidisciplinary services – from clinical trials to psychosocial support to helpful nurse navigators.
